Composting:

- closes the gap on emissions from methane, a more potent greenhouse gas than carbon, from food waste in the landfill
- revitalizes your soil's health without synthetic fertilizers
- fun way to engage with science and nature

SENIOR FOOD PROGRAM

The Pinole Senior Center will be partnering with the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano County on their Senior Food Program. Low-income senior citizens 55+ will be able to receive free groceries, including healthy pantry staples, eggs, cheese and assorted meats twice a month. The program at the Pinole Senior Center is available for Pinole senior residents ONLY. It will be every 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month starting Tuesday, February 28th. Distribution will be 10:30 am - 11:30 am.

If you are interested in the program all individuals must complete the Senior Food Program Application. Applications are available at the Front Desk of the Senior Center and can be

submitted Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 am - 1 pm. In addition, applications can be submitted on the day of the food pick up. Individuals must bring proof of age such as an ID or Driver's License and proof of home address which can be a PG&E bill, water bill, or statement listing out the name and residence of the individual.
