CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

Costa County is currently in the less restrictive Orange Tier of the State's Blueprint for a Safer Economy on Wednesday, April 7.

Given the progress that we are making on COVID-19 vaccinations and the expectation that the State will begin to substantially reopen over the next few months, the City is tentatively planning to reopen key facilities and services, barring any setbacks in the fight against COVID, as follows:

- The Recreation Department will reopen the Senior Center, Tiny Tots, and Youth Center facilities for limited in-person activities on June 15, 2021.
- City Hall will reopen to walk-in customers on June 15, 2021. Some services will continue to be offered primarily by appointment or through online tools.
- Staff intends to complete preparations such that City Council meetings can be held in person in the Council Chambers beginning in early summer.

The City will take a safe and phased approach to reopening facilities and programs and will likely need to limit the number of in-person participants initially. More information on the timing and availability of specific programs and services is forthcoming. The tentative timelines noted above are subject to change based on changes in the trajectory of COVID-19.

Contra Costa County must remain in the Orange Tier for at least three weeks before moving into the next, less restrictive yellow tier. The Community Services Commission is comprised of seven members who must be Pinole residents. The Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council in matters pertaining to public recreation, parks, arts and cultural activities, historical activities, public access television activities, senior and youth activities, and community services. The Commission reviews and recommends policies and procedures governing recreation, park, and community services for approval by the City Council; maintains relationships with schools, community, and civic organizations; advocates for recreation and community services for the community; and collaborates with civic clubs, nonprofit organizations, and citizen groups to provide funds, property and or volunteerism for the development and operation of parks and recreation facilities. The Community Services Commission meets monthly on the 4th Wednesday at 5 pm. Commissioner's service two-year terms.

Traffic and Pedestrian Safety Committee (2 positions)


