#### **CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE**

The County has issued a new Health Order, effective September 22,2021. As of Sept. 22, 2021, everyone 12 years and older must show proof of full COVID-19 vaccination, or a negative test result, before going to high-risk indoor businesses such as restaurants, bars, and gyms in Contra Costa County. Workers at these businesses must be fully vaccinated or test weekly, starting Nov. 1, 2021.

To show proof of vaccination, patrons must show photo ID and their vaccination record cards from the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC), or copies or pictures of their cards. Documentation from healthcare providers will also be accepted, as will digital COVID-19 vaccine records issue by the State of California. #### **UPDATE ON BUILDING PERMIT PROCESSING**

Pinole, like many other cities, has been experiencing an unexpected construction boom since COVID-19 began. Many homeowners are undertaking projects to improve their residences. Whereas the City has historically received an average of 70 building permit applications per month over the past few years, since COVID-19 began, the city has been receiving an average of 85 applications per month, including some significant spikes, such as 50 applications over Memorial Day weekend and 50 applications around 4th of July. When COVID-19 began, the city implemented new online tools for building permit application and processing, so that the city could continue to process permits, in a safe manner, and the city has remained open continuously throughout the pandemic for permit processing. Unfortunately, despite new tools and remaining open continuously, this extraordinary volume

has increased the average permit processing timeline from 8 weeks to 14 weeks. Also, coincidentally, the city recently experienced the departure of two key building Staff members. This created a backlog in permit processing. The city has hired new Staff, as well as brought in additional temporary assistance, and is addressing the backlog as well as newly received applications. With improved processes and new Staff, the city expects to address the backlog within the next month or two. Because this building boom is a regionwide phenomenon, there are no additional outside resources that the city can engage to supplement our permanent and temporary Staff. The city recognizes that permitting delays can be disappointing and frustrating. We are working as efficiently and diligently as possible to expeditiously process all permits. We are fortunate that so many members of the community are able to invest in their properties, and we appreciate applicants' patience.

### CA COVID-19 RENT RELIEF PROGRAM: NOW COVERING 100% OF RENT AND UTILITIES FOR INCOME-ELIGIBLE RENTERS AND LANDLORDS

The State of California has increased funding for income-eligible renters and their landlords who have been impacted by COVID-19 to cover 100% of unpaid and future rent or utilities. This increase in rental assistance payments to 100% of unpaid rent will help make landlords whole and keep tenants housed. You can verify your eligibility for the CA COVID-19 Rent Relief program and apply immediately by visiting HousinglsKey.com, or by calling 833-430-2122. Additionally, if you are an applicant who has already received funding through the program, you will be compensated the difference to receive 100% coverage – there is no need to re-apply!

#### AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT WORKSHOP

The Pinole City Council will be holding the first of two special meetings (workshops) to gather public input and make decisions about how to expend the funds that the City will receive from the federal government from the American Rescue Plan Act. The workshop will be held on Saturday, **October 9, 2021, at 9:30 AM–1:30 PM, via Zoom**. The conversation will continue to the second workshop, which will be held on Saturday, November 6, 2021, at 9:30 AM–1:30 PM, so community members are encouraged to participate in both workshops. On August 31, 2021, Congressman Thompson visited the City of Pinole to present the City Council, City Manager, and staff with the City's "big check" for \$4.6 million from the American Rescue Plan Act. The primary eligible uses of the funds are support public health response; provide financial assistance to businesses and individuals; replace lost City revenue; invest in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure.

Food items will be placed in the trunk by staff/volunteers. Parking or exiting your vehicle will not be allowed. All participants must follow social distancing guidelines and wear a face covering. ## CA COVID-19 Rent Relief Program: Now Covering 100% of Rent and Utilities for Income-Eligible Renters and Landlords

The State of California has increased funding for income-eligible renters and their landlords who have been impacted by COVID-19 to cover 100% of unpaid and future rent or utilities. This increase in rental assistance payments to 100% of unpaid rent will help make landlords whole and keep tenants housed. You can verify your eligibility for the CA COVID-19 Rent Relief program and apply immediately by visiting HousingIsKey.com, or by calling 833-430-2122. Additionally, if you are an applicant who has already received funding through the program, you will be compensated the difference to receive 100% coverage – there is no need to re-apply!

California's critical eviction protections have also been extended for renters impacted by COVID-19, through September 30, 2021, to help keep vulnerable families housed.

#### WHO CAN APPLY?

**Renters:** If you are an income-eligible renter, you can apply on your own and receive financial assistance for unpaid rent, dating back to April 1, 2020, or help with future payments, even if your landlord doesn't participate.

If you are an income-eligible renter whose landlord *does* participate in the program, you will need to complete the joint application. Once your landlord applies, you will be notified to submit information to complete the application process.

**Landlords:** If you are a landlord and participate in the COVID-19 Rent Relief program, you can get reimbursed directly for 100% of your eligible renters' unpaid rent, dating back to April 1, 2020.

#### WHAT HELP CAN YOU GET?

Assistance is available for 100% of unpaid rent and utilities, dating back to April 1, 2020, as well as future rent and utility payments. Utility payments will be paid directly to utility providers at 100% of cost, but are limited to a total of 12 months.

#### WHAT ELSE SHOULD YOU KNOW?

The application process has been significantly simplified. It now takes less time to complete, requires less paperwork to be uploaded, and offers helpful tips throughout the application.

Assistance from the CA COVID-19 Rent Relief program does NOT count as earned income for renters and will NOT affect eligibility for any other California state benefit assistance programs, such as CalFresh and CalWORKS. All applicant information is kept private and will not be shared. Income-eligible applicants may qualify regardless of immigration status and will not be required to show proof of citizenship.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

To check eligibility and apply, visit HousingIsKey.com or call 833-430-2122. Once your application has been processed, you will be notified about your application status and next steps.

If you need assistance in another language or need help checking eligibility, filling out your application or uploading paperwork, schedule an appointment with a local organization near you by calling 833-687-0967.







# Get 100% of your rent and utilities paid.

If COVID-19 has impacted your ability to pay or receive rent and utility payments, the State of California is here to help you. Income-eligible renters and their landlords may receive 100% financial assistance through the CA COVID-19 Rent Relief program.

#### Both renters and landlords are encouraged to apply.

Get help with 100% of your unpaid rent and utilities dating back to April 1, 2020, as well as future rent payments. Utility assistance will be paid directly to the utility provider.

Assistance from the CA COVID-19 Rent Relief program does not count as earned income for renters and will not affect eligibility for other state benefit assistance programs. You won't be asked about citizenship and your information will be kept private.
