This way to a greener, fairer, and more resilient Pinole! On October 2021, our City Council declared Climate а Emergency. This recognized detrimental effects climate change can have on Pinole's public health. economy, infrastructure, and overall wellbeing.

With a Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (CAAP), a collaborative effort by City Staff and Pinole citizens, the city can strategize how to become resilient to and

mitigate the effects of a Climate Emergency. Some examples of resilience are adding porous pavement that can impede danger and damage in the event of flooding or planting more trees to keep temperatures lower during an extreme heat event. Some examples of climate mitigation are reducing greenhouse gas emissions by electrifying homes and buildings and reducing the amount of gas vehicles on the road with improved infrastructure for walkability and clean transportation.

An important element of the CAAP will also emphasize equity. Climate change disproportionately affects socially vulnerable populations so it is vital to level the playing field so that all communities can mitigate and overcome climate change without compromising on quality of life and access to resources and opportunity.

The CAAP is an exciting journey for all Pinole citizens to embark on to reach our common destination: a cleaner and healthier Pinole that is better prepared, more kind to the Planet, and fairer to its people.

### NOTICE TO MERCHANTS -- LICENSE RENEWAL TIME

Attention Business Owners – 2022 Pinole Business Licenses will expire on December 31, 2022. Business license taxes for 2023 are due on December 31, 2022, and become delinquent on February 1, 2023, at which time unpaid taxes are subject to a 50% penalty. There is a change to the business license tax rate for calendar year 2023. The tax for the basic business license is \$160.00 per year (not including the \$4.00 AB 1379 state mandated fee).

Business license renewal forms are being mailed out November 23, 2022. Renewal forms are mailed to you as a courtesy; we make every effort to make sure that a renewal form is mailed to each active business. If you do not receive a renewal form, it is the business owner's responsibility to pay the business license tax by January 31, 2023. Please remit your payment to:


